

Report on the training sessions

After developing the beta version of the Lymphoma Registry, we organized training sessions with specialists who will be involved in using the registry.

The purpose of these training sessions is to provide support for the data coding activity, as implemented in the proposed solution, by describing the corresponding international classifications and their implementation principles. The training aims to familiarize specialists with the registration practices, with the ICD-O-3 coding system, with the practice of lymphoma staging and with the ways of entering data in an online platform.

The sessions included a series of interactive and individual exercises, as well as general discussions.

The detailed agenda for these training sessions, which took place over 2-3 hours, is:

- Introduction to the coding systems of malignancies: a brief presentation of the coding systems of topography, morphology, behavior and grade - ICD-O and ICD10. Online use of ICD-O.
- 2016 revision of the WHO (WHO) classification of lymphoid neoplasms - Coding rules for topography, morphology, behavior and grade.
- Coding stage - specific principles and aspects.
- Using the ontology-based NextGenReL software solution.
- Interactive and individual exercises.
- Open discussions.
